CONSTITUENT ASSOCIATION MEMBER – CRITERIA FOR COMPLIANCE

This document is used to outline the criteria that is required to be satisfied to maintain compliance as a Basketball Tasmania Constituent Association Member (CAM).

1. Have objects that align with BTAS' Objects and do all that is reasonably necessary to enable BTAS' objects to be achieved
2. Conduct domestic basketball competitions for more than 15 teams for at least one season of 15 weeks each year
3. At all times act for and on behalf of the interests of BTAS, the Members and Basketball
4. Be responsible and accountable to BTAS for fulfilling its respective obligations under BTAS' strategic plan as revised from time to time
5. Provide BTAS with copies of its audited accounts, annual report and associated documents immediately following its annual general meeting
6. Provide BTAS with copies of its business plans and budgets from time to time and within 14 days of request by the Board
7. Be bound by this Constitution, the BA constitution and the General Statues and Internal Regulations
8. Act in good faith and loyalty to maintain and enhance BTAS and Basketball, its standards, quality and reputation for the collective and mutual benefit of the Members and Basketball
9. At all times operate with, and promote, mutual trust and confidence between BTAS and the Members, promoting the economic and sporting success, strength and stability of each other; and work cooperatively with each other in the pursuit of the Objects

- 10.** Maintain a database of all Affiliates and Individual Members Registered with it in accordance with this Constitution and provide a copy to BTAS upon request from time to time by the Board in such means as may be required
- 11.** Not do or permit to be done any act or thing which might adversely affect or derogate from the standards, quality and reputation of Basketball and its maintenance and development
- 12.** Advise BTAS as soon as practicable of any serious administrative, operational or financial difficulties
